1. Arrive/Depart indicates required arrival and departure time for each leg in order for the Stage to stay on schedule throughout the entire route. Since no allowance is made for changing teams, meals, ferry crossings, etc., each Stage driver is required to increase his mileage per hour to make up for any loss of time. The result is that stages frequently arrive well before their scheduled arrival times at the next leg but always (unless there is a mishap) leave on time.

2. Night stop: Some Stages in settled areas will continue to press on throughout the night on their schedules with passengers sleeping as they are able in the coach. In the territories, however, they frequently layover in towns or secure home stations for safety reasons.

3. At Rancho Bucareli, there is a terminus for a local westbound stage (The Addison Line) that shuttles mail and passengers back and forth between Roca De Galleon (25 miles away) and Rancho Bucareli. It runs daily with two coaches - one heading back east and one heading west in rotation.

4. Time Allowed: The average mph between legs varies wildly, depending on road conditions and terrain. For example, the route between Muskeegie and Silverton is particularly difficult.
